Dear Members,

COVID 19 has been a social and an economic crisis as much as it is a health emergency. Fortunately, most businesses are on the path to life much as they were before the outbreak of pandemic. Additionally, Government of Tamil Nadu has promised TCCI to look into our demand for better road connectivity to improve trade and commerce between SCR and their State, especially Southern parts of Tamil Nadu.

I thank all Trade and Professional organisations in the Capital for joining hands with TCCI to work towards enhanced development of our SCR. We have





been supported in this endeavour by Trivandrum Agenda Task Force (TATF) and Awake Trivandrum.

It has been an honor to serve as President of one of the oldest and distinguished Trade bodies in the State for a second consecutive term. I am filled with gratitude to countless people and organisations that helped me in discharging my Office; especially to my team of Office Bearers and an active Executive Committee.

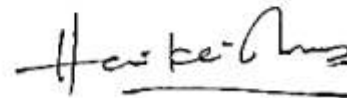

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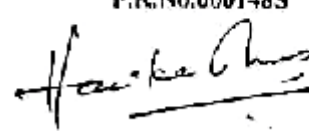
