

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President's Message



Dear Members,

It is with immense pride and responsibility that I present the 70th Annual Report of the Trivandrum Chamber of Commerce and Industry (TCCI), an Institution that has stood as the voice of the Capital Region Business and Industrial fraternity since 1951.

Over the past year, we have witnessed a transformative shift in the developmental landscape of the Capital Region. TCCI has remained steadfast in championing infrastructure-led growth, Economic empowerment and policy engagement that is futuristic, inclusive and driven by merit—not by any Partisan, Religious or Sectional interest.

This year is particularly significant for TCCI, as it coincides with three important milestones: the upcoming Local Body Elections in November 2025, the Kerala Legislative Assembly Elections in May 2026 and the Platinum Jubilee of the Chamber in 2026.

As President, I firmly believe that the next Mayor Nominee of all Political Parties of Trivandrum should be a person with stature and respectability who can deliver the clear Development Agenda for our Capital City. Besides, in the forthcoming Assembly Elections, we urge all Political Parties to give and include a strong and specific commitment to the Capital City and Region's development in their respective Election Manifesto.

Being a Platinum Jubilee year for TCCI, we need to observe and celebrate this occasion in a befitting manner. Personally, I feel we should invite the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India to inaugurate this historic event.

With the successful arrival of 355 ships and handling of over 7,60,411 TEU containers as on date, Vizhinjam Port has entered a historic operational phase. It is no longer a dream but a functional gateway that has already surpassed several Regional Ports in transshipment volume. The official commissioning by the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India on 2nd May 2025 marks a pivotal step in India's emergence as a Global Maritime Power.

TCCI's unwavering commitment and constant intervention—particularly in overcoming barriers and Public perception challenges—played a vital role in realizing this Project. We are now closely engaged in discussions for its integration into a larger Multi-modal Logistics and Industrial Ecosystem.

The Airport has seen flight operations rise from 40 to over 100 daily and passenger traffic surges threefold to over 15,000 per day, post-privatization. TCCI's early interventions, including the 2022 Airline Summit we organized, played a catalytic role in these developments.

We are actively working with Stakeholders to introduce new international routes and are



involved in ongoing efforts to expand infrastructure, including acquisition for RESA (Runway End Safety Area). Our credibility is reinforced by the Government regularly nominating TCCI to policy-making Committees.

Consistent follow up on NHAI Roadworks, Smart City Roads and the proposed Outer Ring Corridor, will reshape connectivity in and around Trivandrum.

On the Rail front, we have engaged with State and Central Authorities to push for new train services, signal modernization, lane doubling and the enhancement of the Trivandrum Central, North, South Stations.

A defining aspect of our efforts is the proactive vision for the Trivandrum Metro Rail Project. We not only advocated for its revival but conducted technical studies suggesting an innovative Tunnel-based alignment for optimal space and minimal disruption. Numerous representations have been made to the Hon'ble Prime Minister, Chief Minister of Kerala, MPs and MLAs. The concept of a Tunnel Metro, in our view, ensures future-proof, sustainable and high-quality Urban transit.

Our developmental philosophy is not aimed at short-term visibility but at long-term sustainability. Reiterating that infrastructure should serve generations, not just Governments. Every Project we support—be it a Highway, Port, Metro or Airport—is aligned with this principle of quality,

continuity and inclusivity.

Government of Kerala has officially recognized TCCI as a key Stakeholder in development dialogues. Partnering in the Vizhinjam Investment Meet 2025 (as part of the Invest Kerala Global Summit 2025) held at Hyatt Regency in Trivandrum is a clear acknowledgment of our influence and standing.

Besides, our interventions extend beyond infrastructure-we have continuously supported our Members and our Associated Organizations in resolving issues through proactive engagement with Authorities.

On an average, two new high-impact Members join TCCl every month, adding strategic depth and value to our network. Today, both Domestic and International Investors approach us for guidance. Our Office is active, responsive and engaged every single day.

Finally, we remain committed to our vision—a vibrant, connected and future-ready Trivandrum. As we enter a new term, I call upon every Member to actively engage, contribute ideas and stand united in our mission to uplift the Capital Region of Kerala into an International Model of sustainable urban and economic development.



MINUTES OF MEETING OF 70th ANNUAL GENERAL BODY MEETING (AGM) held on 30th JUNE 2024 at 7:30 PM Venue: Chamber Hall, Kowdiar, Thiruvananthapuram

I. Prayer

The Chamber Prayer song was played.

2. Calling the Meeting to Order

Meeting was called to Order by President S N Raghuchandran Nair at 5:30 pm. Following Members were present.

3. Welcome & Presidential Address

President welcomed all the Members and informed the following: -

Over the past year, TCCI has remained at the forefront of policy advocacy, infrastructure development and Stakeholder engagement in the Capital Region.

We continued to assertively pursue clarity on critical infrastructure matters, notably distinguishing the Vizhinjam Port Project from unrelated local concerns such as the Mudalappozhi Fishing Harbour. Our consistent messaging through Media and interactions with Stakeholders has helped maintain this distinction.

TCCI has been actively involved in developments related to the Vizhinjam International Seaport, including participation in Public hearings and supporting Branding efforts to include "Thiruvananthapuram" in the Port's Official name. We are pleased to note the arrival of the trial vessel in July 2024 and look forward to engaging further with the Port authorities.

On the Thiruvananthapuram International Airport, we have been pressing for the acquisition of the remaining land needed for runway expansion and improved connectivity. We also submitted a Memorandum to Chief Minister for the introduction of direct flights from Trivandrum to Washington D.C. under the Capital-to-Capital initiative.

In rail infrastructure, we petitioned for the extension of the second Vande Bharat train to Thiruvananthapuram and participated in Stakeholder consultations for the Trivandrum Metro Project. We reiterated our demand for a traditional Metrorail system under the aegis of a competent agency like Delhi Metro, rather than a Light Tram System.

Review meetings were with the Chief Minister's Office and various Departments on 30 key development Sectors, including IT, Roads, Seaport, Airport, and Railways. Updates were also shared on major Projects like the Film City, Technopark expansion, and City Flyovers at Enchakkal and Thiruvallam.

Our role in promoting Chalai Bazaar as a Walking Street, participating in consultations on the Trivandrum Master Plan 2044, and driving Smart City Road Works was also significant. In the Banking Sector, we initiated dialogue with senior SBI Officials to enhance business-friendly operations and plan to organize interactive sessions with our Members.

Support was extended for investment promotion through events such as the Trivandrum Investment Meet (TIM) and the Global Travel Market (GTM), which drew international participation and highlighted our City's potential. We are also examining the feasibility of institutionalizing GTM as an annual event.



Besides, TCCI collaborated with the Swasthi Foundation to support health initiatives like the Preventive Oncology Conference, reinforcing our commitment to the well-being of our Society.

Furthermore, we actively contributed inputs for Election Manifestos of the various Political Fronts, highlighting Trivandrum's pressing infrastructure and Industry needs.

In conclusion, Chamber remains committed to being the voice of Trade and Industry in Trivandrum. I urge all Members to stay actively engaged and share your valuable insights as we collectively strive for the growth and prosperity of the Capital Region and its Commercial Ecosystem.

4. Annual Report

Secretary Shri Abraham Thomas (Joji) presented the 69th Annual Report which was printed and circulated earlier. This was taken as read, adopted and approved.

Raghuchandran Nair, presented the Audited Statement of Accounts and Balance Sheet for the Financial Year ended 3 Ist March 2024. The documents had been circulated to the Members in advance, who reviewed and approved the Audited Statement of Accounts and Balance Sheet as presented.

7. Appointment of Auditor for 2024-2025



Report on the audit of the Standalone financial statement

Opinion

We have audited the standalone financial statements of THE TRIVANDRUM CHAMBER OF COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY, which comprises the balance sheet as at 31st March 2025, the Statement of Profit and Loss for the year then ended, and a summary of significant accounting policies and other explanatory information.

In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, the aforesaid standalone financial statements give the information required by the Companies Act, 2013 in the manner so required and give a true and fair view in conformity with the accounting principles generally accepted in India, of the state of affairs of the Company as at March 31, 2025 and its statement of profit and loss, for the year ended on that date.

Basis for Opinion

We conducted audit in accordance with the Standards on Auditing (SAs) specified under section 143(10) of the Companies Act, 2013. Our responsibilities under those Standards are further described in the Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements section of our report. Ourselves independent of the Company in accordance with the Code of Ethics issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India together with the ethical requirements that are relevant to our audit of the financial statements under the provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 and the Rules there under, and we have fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with these requirements and the Code of Ethics. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion.





Key Audit Matters

Key audit matters are those matters that, in our professional judgment, were of most significance in our audit of the financial statements of the current period. These matters were addressed in the context of our audit of the financial statements as a whole, and in forming our opinion thereon, and we do not provide a separate opinion on these matters.

Emphasis of Matters

We draw attention to the following matters in the Notes to the standalone financial statements. Our Opinion is not qualified in respect of these matters:

- We refer in Note No.1- Notes forming part of financial statements, The Trivandrum Chamber of Commerce and Industry is a Non-Trading Company incorporated in 1951, under the Non Trading Companies Act 1961, the audit and annual returns are only to be complied as per the Companies, Act 2013 with the Registrar, Non- Trading Company, Kerala and not with the Registrar of Companies as per the Companies, Act, 2013.
- 2. We refer in Note No.2 (g) Tangible and Intangible Fixed assets and Depreciation, Chamber is continuously following Depreciation as per the rates as prescribed in Income Tax Act 1961 and no revaluation done during the year. As per the Schedule II of Companies Act 2013, useful lives to compute depreciation have been brought into effect from 1st April 2014.
- 3. In accordance with the provisions of the GST Act, an Association of Persons (AOP) is required to pay GST if it provides services to non-members and the aggregate value of such supplies exceeds the basic exemption limit of ₹20 lakhs. During the period under audit, it was observed that the value of taxable services rendered to non-members amounted to ₹ 22,87,609.32. Accordingly, GST amounting to ₹ 4,11,769.68, along with applicable interest, is payable on the said supplies.

Information Other than the Financial Statements and Auditor's Report Thereon:

The Company's Board of Directors is responsible for the preparation of the other information. The other information comprises the information included in the Management Discussion and Analysis, Board's Report including Annexure to





Board's Report, Business Responsibility Report, Corporate Governance and Shareholder's Information, but does not include the Financial Statements and our auditor's report thereon.

Our opinion on the Financial Statements does not cover the other information and we do not express any form of assurance conclusion thereon.

In connection with our audit of the financial statements, our responsibility is to read the other information and, in doing so, consider whether the other information is materially inconsistent with the financial statements or our knowledge obtained during the course of our audit or otherwise appears to be materially misstated.

If, based on the work we have performed, we conclude that there is a material misstatement of this other information; we are required to report that fact. We have nothing to report in this regard.

Responsibilities of Management and Those Charged with Governance for the Standalone Financial Statements

The Company's Board of Directors is responsible for the matters stated in Section 134(5) of the Companies Act, 2013 with respect to the preparation of these financial statements that give a true and fair view of the financial position, financial performance and cash flows of the Company in accordance with the accounting principles generally accepted in India, including the Accounting Standards specified under Section 133 of the Act, read with Rule 7 of the Companies (Accounts) Rules, 2014.

This responsibility also includes maintenance of adequate accounting records in accordance with the provisions of the Act for safeguarding of the assets of the Company and for preventing and detecting frauds and other irregularities; selection and application of appropriate accounting policies; making judgments and estimates that are reasonable and prudent; and design, implementation and maintenance of adequate internal financial controls, that were operating effectively for ensuring the accuracy and completeness of the accounting records, relevant to the preparation and presentation of the financial statements that give a true and fair view and are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.
